1 Please fill out one Twin Sisters Order Form per project. Note Project Name where indicated on the form.

If a Plant is not on the list, ADD IT TO THE BOTTOM of the list and we will do our best to source seed or seedlings.

- 2 Send completed form to officemanager@twinsistersnursery.com and seed@twinsistersnursery.com
- 3 Sales will send you an estimate through QuickBooks for each project.
- 4 Review estimate('s). If correct return signed copy to **officemanager@twinsistersnursery.com** and **seed@twinsistersnursery.com**
- 5 If changes need to be made or there is an error let us know and we will revise and send a new estimate. Then follow step 4 again.
- 6 Once a signed estimate is received, Finance will request a 25% deposit invoice to confirm your order (Due on Day). This deposit is non-refundable should your order be canceled. Confirmation of deposit will place your order on our Master Order List. An additional 25% non-refundable deposit (Due on Day) will be required once the seed is sown and growing. All orders are subject to an additional 25% cancelation fee (Due on Day).
- 7 If changes/updates need to be made after we have received a signed estimate, or you wish to cancel your order please email officemanager@twinsistersnursery.com and seed@twinsistersnursery.com
- 8 The remainder of your payment is due one (1) week after picking up your order.

Terms and Conditions of Sale.

- A While we will do our best to accommodate your requests, any orders received after the deadline cannot be guaranteed Client is not required to pay for the services on undelivered seedlings in the event that Twin Sisters Native Plants Nursery (TSNPN) is unable to fulfill the contractual Agreement, with the exception of the non-refundable portion of the deposit paid, up
- B until that time which it is applied to the costs of service provided.

All seed for propagation will be provided by Client and shipped to TSNPN at Client's expense. All seed will be owned by Client, and any seed TSNPN supplies or purchases from a third party at the request of Client will be sold at cost+10% to Client and then deemed for all purposes to be seed supplied and owned by Client. All materials, other than the seed, for fulfilling the Seedling

- C Management Services Agreement will be provided at TSNPN expense.
 Seedling management service prices include costs related to seed preparation up to 2 hrs per species; if more time is required it will be charged at \$65 per hour. Also covered are all costs associated with seed stratification, growing, contract management,
- D and preparation for shipping including packaging, boxing, and palletizing.
